## A guide to using PANDA



**PANDA** is our new Online Learning Platform. It has everything you need to know about virtual learning, for all year groups and all subjects – in one place!

Our online learning platform can be used if your child is self-isolating or if a class bubble must close.

Each year group will be uploaded weekly to ensure the children have access to the same learning, regardless if they are at home or school.




### 2. Click on your child's year group.




3. Click on Home Learning

5. All the resources you require for this week will be in this folder, including the teacher's planning for each subject.




# 6. You will also notice on the year group page, in the top right corner, quick access to our most used apps.
